Methodology

Research Question: How does students' character develop?

Character Growth Index (Liston, 2012)

• 88 items across four-character dimensions: respect, responsibility, caring, and motivation.

Interviews

 27 participants: 18 students and 9 staff members who had worked at the school for at least 5 years.
