



# Example Case: Greek Columns Project Differentiation and Cross-Disciplinary Approach Incorporation of Subjects

#### **Differentiated Art Project**

Some students drew the columns online, some students captured pictures, some students created a powerpoint of the columns. Some students watched documentaries online and completed a quiz.

- Math: Geometry- Calculating Volume and Surface Area
- History: Map Skills + Historical Timeline
- ELA: Writing a descriptive essay + Making the connection between ancient Greece and architecture today!



We visited a few buildings in Augusta, Georgia with Greek and Roman influence.

### Measuring Mastery and Final Deliverables

#### **Measuring Mastery**

- Rubrics to assess historical accuracy,.
- Self-Reflection and Peer Review for ongoing feedback.
- Progress Checkpoints throughout the project for individualized support.

- Presentation explaining the design process and how math, history, and ELA were incorporated.


